

# KEY INVESTOR INFORMATION

This document provides you with key investor information about this fund. It is not marketing material. ## LYXOR EPSILON GLOBAL TREND FUND A-EUR (the "Fund")

ISIN: IE00B61N8946 - A sub-fund of the investment company named LYXOR INVESTMENT STRATEGIES PLC (the "Company") domiciled in Ireland. Managed by Lyxor Asset Management S.A.S. ("LAM")

### Objectives and investment policy

The Fund seeks to achieve capital appreciation over the medium to long term by implementing the Lyxor Epsilon Global Trend Strategy. The Lyxor Epsilon Global Trend Fund investment strategy provides exposure to several asset classes on the global markets (including equities, bonds, interest rates, volatility and currencies), according to a systematic model based investment process. Such systematic model-based process aims at implementing a trend following strategy that seeks to identify upward and downward price trends and to capitalize on them. Such process relies on quantitative signals (some of which are price momentum and volatility signals), combines medium term and long term approaches and is subject to an ongoing improvement by a dedicated research team.

The share currency is the Euro (EUR).

- **Invested financial instruments:** Financial Derivatives Instruments (FDI), structured debt securities, fixed income securities and money market instruments, cash deposits and near cash instruments.
- **Dividend policy:** all the Fund's amounts available for distribution (if any) shall not be distributed to Shareholders, but reinvested.
- **Net Asset Value:** the Net Asset Value per share is calculated on each Business Day or such other day or days as may be determined by the Directors and notified to Shareholders in advance.
- **Redemptions:** redemption requests shall be received on any Business Day (D) at or before 12:00 PM Irish Time to be executed on the Net Asset Value of D calculated as of D+1.

### Risk and reward profile



The risk-return category shown above is based on the maximum level of risk that the Fund manager may take while adhering to the Fund's strategy, as well as on its performance, where applicable. This risk estimate may therefore not represent a reliable indicator of future risk, and may be subject to change over time. The lowest category does not mean risk free investment.

The Fund has been classified within category 5. Category 5 indicates that under normal market conditions a significant loss of capital is possible ; the value of your investment may change significantly and have above average daily upside or downside variation.

Main risks not covered by the above indicator which could lead to a decrease in the net asset value of the Fund and which the Fund is authorized to disclose in this document (for more details about risks, please refer to the Risk Profile section of the prospectus):

- **Counterparty risk:** the Fund is exposed to the risk that any credit institution with which it has concluded an agreement or a transaction could become insolvent or otherwise default. If such an event occurs, you could lose a significant part of your investment.
- **Credit risk:** the Fund is exposed to the risk that the credit quality of any direct or indirect debtor of the Fund (be it a state, a financial institution or a corporate) deteriorates or that any such entity defaults. This could cause the net asset value of the Fund to decline.
- **Liquidity risk:** in certain circumstances, financial instruments held by the Fund or to which the value of the Fund is linked could suffer a temporary lack of liquidity. This could cause the Fund to lose value, and/or to temporarily suspend the publication of its net asset value and/or to refuse subscription and redemption requests.
- **Risk of using FDI:** the Fund invests in financial derivative instruments in order to reach its investment objective. These instruments may include a range of risks which could lead to their adjustment or result in their early termination. This could lead to the loss of a part of your investment.
- **Capital at risk:** the initial capital invested is not guaranteed. As a consequence, investor's capital is at risk and the amount originally invested may not be recovered.
- **Market disruption risk:** in the event of a market disruption event (ie: impossibility or impracticability to value any investment made by the Fund) the subscription and redemption of shares and/or calculation of the NAV of the Fund will be suspended.

## Charges for this Fund

The charges you pay are used to pay the costs of running the Fund including the costs of marketing and distributing it. These charges reduce the potential growth of your investment.


## Past performance
